The Koondoola Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2017. There are costs associated with providing quality educational opportunities for our students and these are outlined. When planning months in advance, we cannot be sure of exact costs, but we hope the estimates provided, will assist parents in budgeting for these possible expenses.



Please note, that some costs indicated, will only apply to certain students. For example, not all students will attend Interschool competitions including athletics, etc.

Here is a summary of the schedule is below, followed by more detailed information.

1. SCHOOL VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION (Kindergarten to Year 6 inclusive)

Government Schools can ask for up to \$60.00 maximum per child as set in the School Education Regulations 2000. Our voluntary contribution is set much lower in recognition of the difficulties facing parents in the current economic climate.

Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure. Whilst contributions are voluntary, the opportunities we can offer your child will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

2. SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

Information collected in relation to charges in previous years has informed our 2017 Charges Schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the attached schedule represent the maximum charged for scheduled activities in 2017 and in reality some of these areas will work out to be less. You will only be charged the actual cost of the activity. You will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches or you can make an upfront payment for the year.

The Charges Schedule includes costs associated with Specific learning activities available to all students but conditional on a payment being made *e.g. incursions, excursions, swimming etc.*

OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

There are a number of other activities that are purely optional and which only become a cost according to your personal choice. These include things such as School photographs, Graduation Shirt, etc.

We have negotiated competitive prices for the materials on Pupil Requirement lists but you are not obliged to use our supplier.

Parents are reminded that students will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year
